- Provision of 12 Proofs of Death issued by Cassidy Funeral Home (Our proofs of death are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial "Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from Service Ontario.
- Documentation/regulatory fees, general duty vehicle

either by: cash, certified cheque, or bank draft. Deceased will be transferred directly from place of death to our facility then to the crematorium during daytime business hours. This will include 12 funeral director's statements of death and CPP death benefit forms for you to complete. The remains will be returned to the funeral home in an included basic plastic urn.

Newspaper death notices are extra, obituary on our website is included. Additional statements of death are available at extra cost. This does not include an urn suitable for display at service or to retain at home. Funeral staff assistance for service at cemetery or church is extra; use of funeral chapel is also additional.

DISBURSEMENTS

The following, often identified as disbursements, are items arranged for and possibly paid for by us on your behalf.

Coroner's Certificate fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place (at cost). The current fee of \$75.00 is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services (at cost). In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Newspaper notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or other media outlets (at cost).

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary (at cost).

Organist/musician – this is an amount paid to the organist/soloist/musician for music performed at the ceremony (at cost).

Grave Opening and Closing fee – amount payable to the licensed cemetery for this service, may include an overtime fee on certain days or times as required by the cemetery (at cost).

Cemetery Interment fee – amount payable to the licensed cemetery for grave for clean-up, grass seeding and maintenance after interment (at cost).

Cremation Fee – amount payable to the licensed crematorium for cremation service (at cost).

Third party suppliers: We will not accept caskets supplied by casket stores, woodworkers or home-made containers for the burial or cremation of a child or adult remains. Urns however, will be accepted and our staff will place cremated remains in said urns or jewellery, provided the purchaser signs a waiver of responsibility as to the product quality and integrity.

PAYMENT, FINANCING AND FUNDING

We offer our clients various payment, financing and funding options.

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, we require a 25% down payment and balance to be paid in full within 15 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, or bank draft. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5% per month which is equivalent to 18% per annum.

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

Funding (Pre-payment – pre-arranged funeral contracts)

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest, until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled. In the event of a cancellation after 30 days, the money returned will be paid directly to the purchaser and NOT to a third party provider. A cancellation fee of 10% to a maximum of \$350.00 applies.

Note: Payment for pre-arranged contracts in Ontario must be paid by cheque, cash, or bank draft. Credit cards cannot be used.
